Brighton Awards – The Ray Parry Award

The Ray Parry Award is a perpetual award that was instituted in the 1996/1997 season to recognise the past efforts and of Mr Ray Parry. Until the end of the 2012/2013 season, it was awarded at the end of each season to one of Brighton's Clubs. At the 2012 AGM, the membership agreed to move away from the Club Concept and for the 2013/2014 season, the Ray Parry Award was not presented.

A new criterion was established with the award to be presented at the end of the 2014/2015 season. The award continues to be a perpetual award however in recognition of Ray's wide spread contribution to Little Athletics at Brighton and beyond as an adult volunteer, the award has been renamed to the "Ray Parry Volunteer of the Year Award". This is now awarded at the end of each season to an adult from the Brighton Little Athletics Community.

The winner of the Ray Parry Volunteer of the Year award for the 2020/21 season was Christine du Toit.
